AUGRES-SIMS-WHITNEY FIRE AUTHORITY: MMR leases space from the fire board. The board has applied for a Michigan grant for Turn Out Gear. The false alarm charges to the marijuana facilities have not been paid. Next meeting is at Whitney Twp, July 19, 2023.

HERITAGE ROUTE AUTHORITY: Trustee Bullock, reported although the weather did not cooperate for the Vintage Car Show, there were approximately 25 cars on display.
